**Sub:** Recognition Certificate for the School under sub-rule (4) of rule 11 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 for the purpose of section 18 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated **03/12/2025** and subsequent correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I, Shri Sanjay Aswale., convey the grant for **provisional recognition** to the **All Saints High School**, Near BMC water filtrations Plant Bhawale village post Lonad Bhiwandi, Thane, Maharashtra 421302.

- **Period of Recognition:** For a period of **Five years**.
- **Effective Dates:** w.e.f 08/12/2025 to 07/12/2030
- **Classes Covered:** For Class I to class VIII

### Conditions for Sanction

1. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize or affiliate beyond **Class VIII**.
2. The school shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure I) and the Maharashtra Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure II).
3. The school shall admit in **Class 1**, to the extent of **25%** of the strength of that class, children belonging to the weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and



provide to them free and compulsory elementary education till its completion. This form shall also be followed in case of pre-primary classes.

4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed as per Section 12(2) of the Act. To receive such reimbursements, the school shall provide a separate bank account.
5. The society/school shall not collect any capitation fee and shall not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any **screening procedure**.
6. The school shall **not deny admission**:  
To any child for lack of age proof.  
On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
7. The school shall ensure:
  - No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education.
  - No child shall be subjected to **physical punishment or mental harassment**.
  - No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
  - Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23.
  - Students with disabilities/special needs are included as per provision of the Act.
  - The teachers are recruited with **minimum qualifications** as laid under section 23(1) of the Act. Current teachers who do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire them within a period of 5 years.
  - The teacher performs his or her duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act.
  - The teachers shall not engage himself or herself for **private teaching activities**.
8. The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
9. The school shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in section 19 of the Act.

10. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act.

13. The School is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, or the Bombay Public Trusts Act 1950.


14. The School is **not run for profit** to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other person.
